	Alison Clark is a multi-award winning Australian artist specialising in animals and African Wildlife painting. Her life-long passion for animals and nature is evident in her sensitively executed works in pastel and oils.
	Regular travel to the wild animals' natural habitats has enabled her to gather reference material and to experience the animals, their lives and environment. This also includes conservation volunteering, where she can spend more time observing, sketching and getting to know the animals, while helping them. These experiences translate into her work. She exhibits regularly in Australia and has works in Australian and international collections.

	Alison has a Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Zoology from La Trobe University, worked at a zoo for six years, and has also studied Art History and Archaeology at La Trobe.
Workshop	During the workshop, Alison will be taking participants through painting an African 'big cat' in pastel in a photorealist style. She will guide participants through the process of underpainting, how to do the different types of fur on the cat, and eyes and nose. At the end we will have a near complete animal.
