Where	Christine Broersen's studio in Shepparton Victoria Address will be given to participants who have registered and paid
Tutor	Christine Broersen has been working primarily in pastels for over 30 years and is known for her realistic still life and portrait works, for which she has won many awards. Her works are inspired by everyday objects, thrift shop finds, and floral arrangements. Christine holds <i>Signature</i> status with the Pastel Society of Victoria, Australia (PSVA) where she has been a member for the past 18 years.
Workshop	This workshop is suitable for artist of all levels. Christine will be covering the importance of proportions and using negative space when creating a portrait, to ensure you capture the likeness. Christine will be providing lots of helpful hints so that all levels of experience are catered for.

	<p>This workshop will be held in Christine's Shepparton Studio.</p> <p>Lunch and refreshments will be provided.</p> <p>Christine will provide the art supplies required for the workshop.</p>
Cost	<p>The fee for PSVA Members is \$280 and for Non-members is \$320 for the two-day workshop (art supplies are provided in the fee). Places will be made open to Members initially and then opened to non-Members if there are places still available.</p> <p>Payment to be made via the Pastel Society of Victoria, Australia's Workshops webpage at https://vicpastel.com.au/workshops/</p> <p>Accommodation and travel costs are not included & should be arranged by each participant themselves.</p>

To Book	<p>Booking is a 2-Step process. Your place in this workshop will only be secured once both the online Registration Form & Payment have been made.</p> <p>Step 1. Register : Go to our Workshops webpage & fill out the online Registration Form & Submit the form online.</p> <p>Step 2. Pay Online : Go to our Workshops webpage & proceed with the online payment.</p> <p>It is expected that this will be a very popular workshop limited to only 14 participants, so to avoid disappointed it is recommended that you book in early.</p> <p><i>When enrolling in a PSVA Workshop we require full payment. Please note that \$50.00 of the Workshop fee is non-refundable. The balance of the fee will be refunded if you cancel at least 7 days prior to the Workshop, but only if your place is filled. The Workshop Coordinator, in consultation with the President and/or Treasurer, has the discretion to alter the above Policy should extenuating circumstances apply.</i></p>
